

# HIGH JUMP ASSIGNMENTS

## 1 CHIEF JUDGE/RECORDER

Conducts pre-event review session, supervises all warm-up activities. Communicates instructions to athletes. Supervises the competition and determines if a jump is legal or illegal.

## 2 CROSSBAR REPLACER

Set the bar at the correct height, replace the bar after each unsuccessful attempt and check the measurement.

## 3 CROSSBAR REPLACER

Set the bar at the correct height, replace the bar after each unsuccessful attempt and check the measurement.

## 4 FLIGHT COORDINATOR/TIMER

Coordinates athletes' warm-up and informs competitors of jumping order, practice jumps, etc. Positions clock in full view of competitors and starts clock when competitors name is called. Signals to Chief Judge if time should expire before the competitor initiates an attempt.

## 5 2ND RECORDER

Records each attempt on the official worksheet.. Assists the Chief Judge in determining a legal jump.

## 6 PERFORMANCE BOARD OPERATOR

Receives metric distance from Recorder and posts distances on performance indicator.
